INSTRUCTIONS FOR PREPARING JVST MANUSCRIPTS

Papers will be reviewed according to criteria set by the JVST and must meet JVST standards for both technical content and written English.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PREPARING JVST MANUSCRIPTS

All manuscripts are refereed to the same standards as regular JVST submissions.

It is **IMPORTANT** that the submitted manuscript <u>has the Program (Paper) Number entered in the top-right corner of the title page</u>. This can be found in the program section on the WoDiM web-page.

- 1. Papers can contain up to a nominal total of 20-25 pages of double-spaced text, tables, figures, references, abstract, etc. If the submitted paper is longer than 25 pages, then the final decision on acceptance for publication will be made by the JVST editors, and will be based on the recommendations of the reviewers.
- 2. A one column format is needed. The text should be double-spaced (the font recommended by the Editor-in-Chief is Times New Roman 12) and pages should have one inch margins on all sides.
- 3. The paper should be sent as a PDF file.
- 4. Figures may appear embedded within the text and/or one per page at the end of the text. Please include a page listing the figure and table captions.
- 5. Multi-component figures may take up more than one page if each component cannot be reduced to 1/6 of a JVST page.

Authors may include their internet e-mail addresses along with all other footnotes.

***PLEASE PROVIDE AT LEAST 3 MATERIAL TERMS, IF APPLICABLE, FOR YOUR MANUSCRIPT IN THE SUBMISSION FORM. THESE ARE NEEDED FOR THE JVST MATERIALS INDEX. THESE ARE TERMS INDICATING WHAT MATERIALS ARE DISCUSSED IN THE ARTICLE (MATERIAL REFERS TO CHEMICAL SUBSTANCE.)

NOTE: Your <u>FIGURES CAN APPEAR ONLINE IN COLOR FOR FREE</u>. To take advantage of this you will need to send the electronic file/s of your figures (as either tif, eps, ps, or high-resolution pdf) file types to the AVS Publications Office upon receiving an email stating that your paper has been received and given a manuscript number. (A single PDF file is all that is needed for your initial conference submission.) Sending color figures in the pdf file used for the review process does not allow for color reproduction (either online or print) at the publishing stage. Only sending each of the figure files directly will facilitate this. A "Publisher's Announcements" email with more details will be sent to you.
